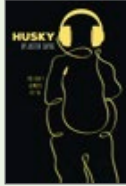

by Justin Sayre

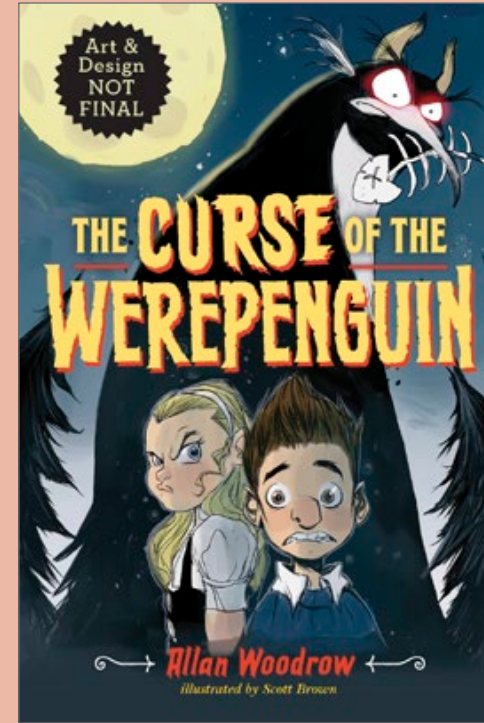
