

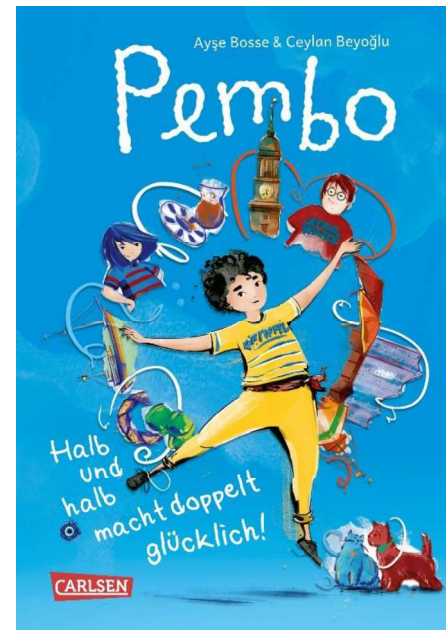
Pembo # 1
