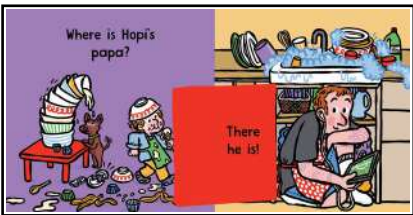
Where are Felix and Theo's pa? There he is! Grabbing a snack from the fridge!

While living in Barcelona, she earned a degree in graphic design and then moved to the UK to study for an MA in children's book illustration. Since then, her books have been translated into 34 different languages! *My Grandpa* (Abrams BYR, 2013) was an Ezra Jack Keats New Illustrator Award Honoree in the US, and *I Am an Artist!* was long-listed for the Kate Greenaway Medal in the UK. Altés has also won the Read It Again! Award and the Nottingham Children's Book Award, and her first book, *No!*, was short-listed for the Peoples Book Prize and the Waterstones Picture Book Prize. Altés lives in London.

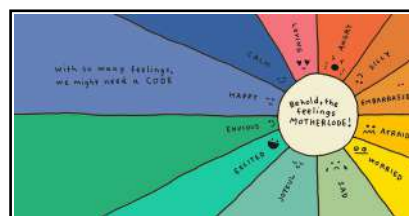
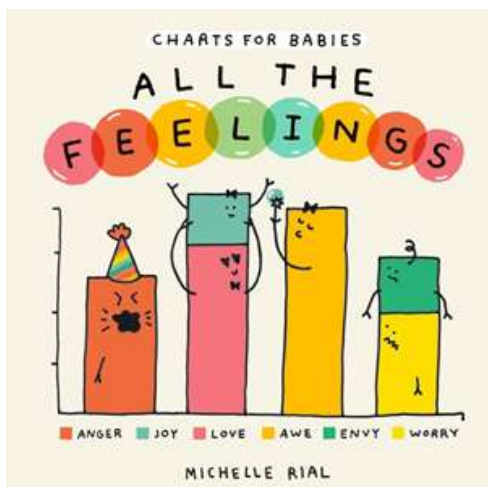

A reassuring, rhyming picture book about sensory overstimulation and what kids can do when a party becomes overwhelming, from the creative team of *Too Much!*

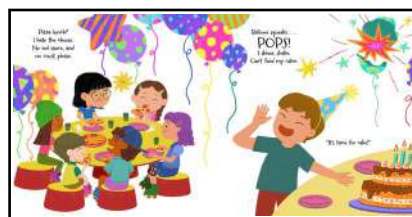


Who *hasn't* felt some anxiety before attending a party? This highly relatable story about a child's experience at a skating rink birthday bash will feel familiar to many kids and their caregivers. From the smells to the food to the VERY loud DJ, it's all totally overwhelming to the main character, who also starred in *Too Much!: An Overwhelming Day*, now in its ninth printing, with seven foreign editions.

Writing from her own experience with sensory processing disorder (SPD), Jolene Gutiérrez's compassionate text explores the struggles of a sensorily sensitive child at a birthday party. Angel Chang's charming illustrations show young readers that it's OK to take a moment for themselves in a quiet spot. An extensive author's note to caregivers and educators explores party panic, how best to prepare for a social event (like creating a script to follow!), and other ways to self-soothe.



Jolene Gutiérrez is an award-winning neurodivergent teacher-librarian who has been working with neurodivergent learners since 1995. Gutiérrez has always been nervous about social gatherings and hopes *Party Panic!* will help readers learn to navigate stressful celebrations. Gutiérrez is also the author of *Too Much!*, coauthor (with Dakota Gutiérrez) of *Mamiachi & Me*, and coauthor (with Minoru Tonai) of *Unbreakable*, which has earned five starred reviews. Gutiérrez lives in Denver with her family. **Angel Chang** is a Taiwanese artist who creates artwork for books and animation. Her illustrated titles include *Most of the Better Natural Things in the World*, *Lunar New Year Around the World*, *A Space for Celeste*, and *Lots and Lots of Ocelots*. She is proud to give a visual voice for perspectives and minds that are less discussed. Chang lives with her cat in Taiwan.

It's 1992 and Josh has everything going for him—a great family, good grades, and lots of friends. But it all grinds to a vicious halt when he's diagnosed with a serious neurological condition. Josh undergoes a dangerous surgery that saves his life but leaves him scarred—both physically and mentally. Battling depression, he finds comfort in the unlikelyst of places: graffiti.

The thrill of making street art gives Josh relief from the pain and trauma—but keeping it secret from his parents, and the police, isn't easy. When he eventually discovers an underground competition presented by Seattle's most infamous street-art crew, Josh is desperate to participate, but will the risk be worth it? After all, the harsh truth about graffiti is that sooner or later . . . you're going to get caught.

Based on Josh Tuininga's experience with the underground street art scene of the '90s, *Serious Damage* also highlights the history of graffiti and the communities and figures who defined the medium, giving depth and context to an often misunderstood art form with extensive back matter and a foreword from noted graffiti historian Alan Ket. This YA graphic novel grapples with themes of depression and recovery while celebrating artistic expression.



Josh Tuininga is an author, artist, and designer living in North Bend, WA. After studying fine art at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, he founded an art and design agency, where he continues to work as its creative director. His work has been published in *Communication Arts* magazine and *HOW* design magazine, and he was awarded with the Communication Arts Award for excellence in illustration. His debut graphic novel *We Are Not Strangers*, was awarded the 2023 Pop Culture Classroom Best YA Nonfiction Award, and was a finalist for the Washington State Book Award. He is also the author of the children's books *Why Blue?* and *Dream On*. His latest work, *Serious Damage*, has received a 4Culture Heritage Grant.
