Many of us are aware of the ethical minefield that is fast fashion: the dodgy labor practices, the lax environmental standards, and the mountains of waste piling up on the shores of developing countries. But far fewer consider the dangerous effects that our clothes have on our own health. Award-winning journalist [Alden Wicker](#) explores the unregulated toxic chemicals that are likely in your wardrobe right now, how they're harming you, and what you can do about it.
