When Zhong Ning'er takes the job, she expects a smash and grab burglary she's doing to make rent and help out a friend. What she doesn't expect: a sad-eyed army boy who dreams of insurrection, a former rebel leader trapped inside a secret lab, and a group of thieves who are first collaborators then compatriots, and then, perhaps, friends.

But this is Beijing, nearly a hundred and fifty years since General Yuan Shikai successfully declared himself the Emperor of China.
